I. God **Knows Me**

O Lord, you have searched me and known me! Psalm 139:1

This is God's **Omniscience**.

A. What we **think**

*You know when I sit down and when I rise up; **you discern my thoughts** from afar.* Psalm 139:2

B. What we **do**

*You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted **with all my ways**.* Psalm 139:3

C. What we **say**

*Even before **a word is on my tongue**, behold, O LORD, you know it altogether.* Psalm 139:4

II. God **Is with Me**

Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? Psalm 139:7

This is God's **Omnipresence**.

A. He is in the **highest** places.

If I ascend to heaven, you are there . . . Psalm 139:8a

B. He is in the **farthest** places.

If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, Psalm 139:9

C. He is in the **darkest** places.

If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night," even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you. Psalm 139:11-12

III. God **Can Do All Things**

. . . Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. Psalm 139:14b

This is God's **Omnipotence**.

A. He **designed** me.

For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made . . . Psalm 139:13-14a

B. He **determines** my steps.

Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them. Psalm 139:16
